Requirements to abstracts

Abstracts (in Ukrainian or English) are submitted in Microsoft Word format –Times New Roman (12 pt), line spacing – single. Abstracts must not exceed 4 pages (A4). Abstract requirements and example are available as separate documents. Participant has 25 minutes for a speech and 5 minutes for a discussion. Presentation should be carried out with a PowerPoint presentation. Languages of the conference – Ukrainian and English. Abstracts will be available in submitted language. Abstracts of reports are accepted until **February 29, 2024**.
