REQUIREMENTS FOR PREPARATION OF ABSTRACTS OF REPORTS:

1. Volume – up to 5 full pages of A4 format.

Editor – Microsoft Word, line spacing – 1.0; font – Times New Roman; font size – 12 pt. Paragraph – 5 characters, without hyphens.

Margins: all – 2.0 cm.

2. Language of materials: Ukrainian or English.

3. Structure of materials:

- title of the article in Ukrainian and English;

- Full names of authors in Ukrainian and English;

- ORCID number of authors (if available);

- abstract in Ukrainian and English;

- keywords (no more than 7 words) in Ukrainian and English;

- text of the article;

- information about each author in Ukrainian and English, indicating: surname, first name and patronymic; academic degree, academic title; place of work and position; office address; phone number, e-mail;

- list of references.

4. Figures (in JPG format) and tables (vertical arrangement) must have a title and a reference to them in the text of the article.

5. Formulas must be typed in the formula editor MathType (references to formulas in the text have the form (1), (2–4)).

6. List of references in alphabetical order (references in the text have the form [1], [2–6]).
