We invite you to take part in International Scientific Conference: **«SCIENTIFIC PRINCIPLES OF GEOLOGICAL-ECONOMICAL ESTIMATION OF THE MINERAL-RAW MATERIAL BASE OF UKRAINE AND THE WORLD»**

The International Scientific Conference will be held in Kyiv (Ukraine) on the campus of the Kyiv National University **18–22, April 2011**.

THEME The Conference is focused on geological and economical problems of the deposits and prospects which are the mineral-raw material base of Ukraine as well as estimation possible ways its development taking into account of world tendencies in industry, economy and technology. It aims to be one of the premier events of the year for both the geological community and for economic geologists.

- Scientific principles of prospecting and estimation of industrial types of deposits during early stages of its exploring
- Searching of the petrography and mineralogical compositions of deposits and estimation of the quality of mineral materials
- New results of investigations of traditional and promising deposits of ores and industrial minerals, including technological kinds
- Ecological problems in mining and utilization of raw materials
- Importance of the mineral-raw mineral bases for sustainable development of Ukraine's and the world's economy.

CALL FOR PAPER The technical program will have a mix of papers in both oral (up to 20 min) and poster (size of poster 120x80cm) format. Intending authors are welcome to suggest into which theme their presentation best fits. Oral papers are limited to one per person. Abstracts will be published before the conference. Papers from the presentations will be published in a proceedings volume after the conference.

LANGUAGE The official conference languages are Ukrainian, English, and Russian.

EXCURSIONS A two days (April 20 – 21) field trip during the Conference will examine spectacular the Zavalia graphite deposit and provide an opportunity to visit some iron deposit of the Kryvyi Rig Region.

Abstracts All intending presenters (oral and poster) must submit a written abstract, by the final abstract deadline (31th December, 2010) for inclusion in the abstract volume. Abstract must be presented in both camera-ready hard copy and electronic (digital) forms. Digital version should be prepared preferably in MS Word. Submit on a floppy disc, CD-R or as an email attachment.

Abstracts are not to exceed 2.0 page in length. The abstract must be formatted as an A4 (210x297mm) page with a 20mm margin at the top, 20mm on the left and bottom margins and a 10mm on the right margin. Abstracts must be typed in single-spaced 9 point Arial Cyr, with text justified to left and right margins. Use only one level of heading in the text. Heading must be left aligned, in 9 point bold, with the first letter of only the first word capitalized. The title of the paper must be in bold 12 point Arial Cyr, capitalized and centre justified. Author names are to be in centre justified 10 point Arial Cyr, separated from the title by a one-line space. Affiliations and/or contact information should follow immediately beneath the authors' names without line spacing. For multi-authored papers, the name of the person speaking or presenting a poster at the convention must be underlined.

Proceedings The proceedings of the meeting will be published after the meeting as both hard copy and CD ROM. Extended synopses to 4 pages are due 18 April, 2011. Concise papers on topics falling within the above conference issues are welcome. Preference will be given to recent progress and must be original work that is not published elsewhere. Please send synopses to the Organizing Committee.
